Themes: Nonfiction | History | Egypt

- Before reading, set the stage with this book trailer featuring author Candace Fleming.
- Play the <u>audiobook excerpt</u> and ask students to identify techniques the author uses to hook readers.
- View the <u>ebook preview</u> to re-read the text in another format. What do students recall after the second reading?
- Ask students to create a fact sheet with the information they have learned. View the author's fact sheet to learn even more.



Starfish

Themes: Poetry | Realistic Fiction | Self-Confidence

- Read the author's blog post. What do we learn about Fipps and her debut novel in verse?
- Play the <u>audiobook excerpt</u>, then talk about "unspoken rules." Use this <u>guide</u> for more discussion ideas.
- Listen to the Meet-the-Author Recording, and learn how personal experiences inspired the book.
- Sample resources for Fipp's new book, And Then, Boom!.

Author Study Ideas

- Introduce the author with his Audio Name Pronunciation.
- Listen to his Meet-the-Author Recordings and ask your students to identify 5 things they learned.
- Browse Alexander's <u>author page</u> to explore resources for books he has written, awards he has won, and interviews he has given.
- Use the share tool to create a shelf card for the <u>author</u> to add to book baskets, displays, or shelves.
