

Book Ideas




Jazz Day: The Making of a Famous Photograph

Themes: Poetry | African American | Musicians

- Explore the author and illustrator <u>interviews</u> for this title. Have students share what they learned.
- Browse the <u>Music Collection</u> and use filters on the left to narrow by African American cultural experience to find more titles to read and enjoy.
