Themes: Picture Book | Realistic Fiction | African

- Introduce the author with her Audio Name Pronunciation.
- Listen as the author explains the importance of the story and the idea that objects around us have endless possibilities in this Meet-the-Author Recording.
- Read the book or view the <u>video book reading</u> and ask discussion questions throughout found in this <u>teacher's guide</u>.
- Support comprehension by having students complete a Story Map Multi-Leveled Lesson.



#### **Drawn Together**

by Minh Lê and Dan Santat

Themes: Picture Book | Graphic Novel | Asian American

- Before you share the book, use the "Teacher's Tool For Navigation" activity in this guide.
- Introduce author Minh Lê and illustrator Dan Santat by playing their Audio Name Pronunciations.
- Watch the <u>complete book reading</u> and keep an eye out at the end for a secret about the book's design.
- Explore this <u>discussion guide</u> for ideas to support and build comprehension.
